Observing the International Day of UN Peacekeepers IASSW conducted a webinar on 29th May, 2022 titled – "Struggles in a war situation & building resiliency". The webinar was hosted on the virtual platform zoom and livestreamed it via IASSW Facebook page for the larger audience. The webinar was moderated by Dr. David McNabb, Member Council for Social Work Education, New Zealand. Speakers were Prof. Shulamit Ramon, University of Hertforshire, she spoke on the topic – Struggles of a social worker during times war and Prof Orit Nuttman-Shwartz, Founder & Interim Dean – School of Social Work at Sapir College, she spoke on the topic – Shared Trauma & building resiliency



Authors are warmly invited to submit abstracts for Oral, Symposium, Workshop, and Poster presentations and invite both traditional papers and innovative contributions of various kinds. Each registered author may submit a maximum of 2 abstracts. Authors need to be clear to indicate which type of presentation their abstracts will fit in.

#### **PRESENTATION TYPES:**

- Oral Presentation
- Oral in Workshop Oral presentation with audience interaction.
- **Oral in Symposium** Oral presentation with 2 or more co-authors per abstract. The abstract should describe the title, the main purpose of the symposium, and 2 or more presentation contents, each with the name of the author. ONLY the coordinator of the symposium must submit the abstract entering all the names of the authors.
- Poster
- Language of presentation: The abstract should be presented in English. All abstracts will be reviewed by the International Scientific Committee who will grade them for inclusion at the Conference. Submissions will be selected through a peer review panel based on scientific merit and relevance of findings.

Call for Abstracts closes: 30th June 2022 Notification of Abstract acceptance: 31st July 2022 Submission of Presentation Material closes: 31st August 2022
