The newly established Africa branch of ICSD hosted its inaugural colloquium on 14 and 15 March 2023 in Johannesburg, South Africa. The Africa branch was delighted to welcome 62 delegates from 12 African countries to this historic event. The colloquium was an intimate in-person gathering that brought together scholars, practitioners, and policymakers to grow and showcase expertise in the field of social development in Africa.

Poverty and inequality have been longstanding challenges in Africa. Crises such as the recent global COVID-19 pandemic, together with the effects of climate change and natural disasters, gender inequality, and conflict and violence, have had a calamitous impact on African lives and the economy.

It was against this backdrop that the colloquium was held under the theme: "When Crises Collide, Social Development Responses to Intersecting Crises in Africa".

The colloquium consisted of eight breakaway sessions with the following sub-themes.

- Social development effects of, and responses to climate change
- Social development responses in promoting gender equality
- Responding to crises through a social development approach

ICSD Treasurer and Board Member Prof. Ben Lough has been appointed Dean of the School of Social Work at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, w.e.f. 16 May 2023. He is a professor of social work and holds a joint appointment as a professor of business administration in the Gies College of Business. Additionally, he serves as the director of social innovation at Gies. Lough's teaching interests revolve around international community development, and social innovation at Gies.

Lough's teaching interests revolve around international community development, nonprofit management, volunteering, and social innovation. He teaches courses on topics such as the nonprofit sector, social

and international social work. His research focuses on transnational voluntary organizations promoting community development and social innovation. Currently, Lough is collaborating with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) on developing a global mental health policy. Recognized for his outstanding achievements, Lough received the Sheth Distinguished Faculty Award for International Achievement from the Office of the Provost in 2018. In 2021, he was honored with the Distinguished Promotion Award, highlighting his exceptional contributions and overall scholarly accomplishments.

Christobel Sanders passed away on 3 May 2023 at the age of 89. Born in Sri Lanka in 1933, Christobel leaves behind a remarkable legacy. She was the beloved wife of Daniel S. Sanders, who served as the two-term president of ICSD. Christobel and Daniel were inseparable partners, embarking on numerous journeys together, and leaving a lasting impact on international social work education. Following Daniel's passing in 1989, Christobel dedicated herself to carry forward his vision for social development. She became a philanthropist, generously supporting social work education and serving as a valuable donor. Together, they established the prestigious Daniel S. and Christobel C. Sanders Fellowship in International Development, the Daniel S. Sanders Peace and Social Justice Memorial Lecture, and the Daniel S. Sanders Lecture for Social Development. Christobel Sanders will be remembered as a compassionate advocate and influential figure in the field of social work. Her contributions have touched many lives and will continue to shape the future of social development. We honor her memory and extend our heartfelt condolences to those who knew and loved her.
